

2017 Young Researcher Awards: Poster Competition Concawe wishes to recognise research by Young Researchers that will contribute to the future sustainability of Europe's oil refining industry.



Following the success of the first editions in 2013 & 2015, Concawe will hold the second Concawe Young Researcher Awards on the occasion of its 12th Symposium, taking place in

Antwerp, Belgium, on 20 & 21 March 2017.

The Concawe Young Researcher Awards will provide a unique opportunity for students, working towards their Ph.D. to gain recognition for their research project, present it to an audience of scientists from the refining industry and related organisations, and benefit from the value of this recognition for their future career. Postgraduate researchers are invited to submit an abstract describing their own work within one of the following 3 categories relevant to the European oil refining industry:

1. Health

- Toxicology and health assessment in the 21st century
- 2. Water

- Novel approaches to the assessment of emissions from refinery waste water treatment facilities and their environmental fate and effects
- 3. Air Quality & Emissions
 - Air quality in cities & transport
- 4. Fuel Quality and Vehicle Emissions
 - Fuel and biofuels quality including related analytical test methods
 - Vehicle and fuels interactions including engine testing
 - Life cycle analysis of fuels, biofuels and alternates

All abstracts will be reviewed by a team of Concawe Member Company experts and judged on four criteria: (1) originality, (2) scientific merit, (3) technical soundness, and (4) quality and clarity.

Students submitting the shortlisted abstracts in each of the 3 categories will be invited to attend the 12th Concawe Symposium in Brussels, Belgium and



Do I qualify as a 'Young Researcher'?

A 'Young Researcher' is a student in a European college or university who is in a postgraduate programme leading to a Masters or PhD degree.

What do I need to do next?

- Abstracts must be submitted electronically to Concawe in the format provided and accompanied by a completed registration form.
- Abstracts and selected poster presentations must be written in English.
- Abstracts must be 300-500 words in length and can be complemented by relevant figures, tables, and references.
- Abstracts should be sent by January 31, 2017 to: young.researcher@concawe.org
- Applicants are advised that Concawe and its Member Companies cannot accept responsibility for late or lost entries.
