



Twin aviation dedicated supply to Heathrow Airport




The UK pipelines managed by BPA

- Improvement in ILI reporting more dents
- System upgrading due to age/standards
- Increasing regulatory requirements
- Rebuilding of Buncefield (following a fire)
- Skills shortage
